Chudleigh Wild is once again organising the Chudleigh Charity Open Gardens event as part of this year's Chudfest. We have a great line up of 12 gardens with a fantastic mix of both regular and new gardens to enjoy over the weekend of 25th & 26th June. We are also pleased to welcome Chudleigh Primary School back to the event, offering a great chance to see the school's wonderful environmental area, including their new raised beds and well-established wildlife pond. Many of the gardens will be demonstrating how people can easily accommodate bees, butterflies, hedgehogs and other wildlife in their gardens.

A range of refreshments, including wood fired pizza, cakes, cream teas, soft drinks, tea and coffee, will be available from some of the gardens. There will also be an opportunity to buy items including plants, bird and bug boxes, beautiful handmade cards and stunning wildlife photography.
